Social justice mural marks proud history

THE Chapel By The Sea community at Bondi Beach will this weekend launch a street art mural designed to celebrate social justice for indigenous people.

Artists Etienne Cohen and Paul Davis collaborated to create the piece, which has already captured the attention of passers by.

The mural shows the faces of five people who fought for the rights of indigenous people, including Eddie Mabo.
